



Call for Applications for the Awarding of Twenty-Four Scholarships for master's degree Programs - 2023/2024 Academic Year

1. Subject Matter of the Competition

Luiss Guido Carli offers twenty-four scholarships to students enrolled for the first year of a master's degree program in the **2023-2024 academic year**.

The scholarships, consisting of a **partial waiver of the University's annual single tuition fee worth € 6,500 each per annum**, will be allocated in accordance with the following criteria:

- 12 scholarships to students already enrolled in a bachelor's degree program or a first-level master at Luiss Guido Carli that meet the [direct admission requirements](#) set by the University;
- 12 scholarships to students who pass the [test during the admission process](#) scheduled for April 2023.

The waiver will be credited against the second and third installments of the University's single tuition fee. Therefore, scholarship winners will have to pay the first installment in full by the deadline that the University sets.

2. Eligibility

This competition is open to students who have completed or are in the process of completing **on track** their bachelor's degree program and who will enroll in the first year of a master's degree program in the 2023/2024 academic year at Luiss Guido Carli by 24 November 2023.

In order to apply:

- students enrolled in a bachelor's degree program must have earned, by the deadline for submission of applications for this competition, at least 135 university education credits with a weighted average grade equal to or greater than 27/30.
- students who have already obtained a bachelor's degree must have completed their undergraduate studies with a weighted average grade equal to or greater than 27/30.
- students enrolled in a first-level master must have obtained their bachelor's degree with a weighted average grade equal to or greater than 27/30.

The competition is not open to students who will be attending their first year abroad in the 2023/2024 academic year because admitted to the following international mobility programs.

- Double Degree in Policies and Governance in Europe with King's College London.



- BI-Luiss Joint MSc in Marketing.

3. Incompatibility

The aid envisaged by this competition is incompatible with other tuition fee waivers or scholarships held for any reason whatsoever, except for those awarded by Italian or foreign institutions designed to support, through periods abroad, a student's education for the academic years covered by this competition.

4. Awarding of the scholarship

For the purposes of compiling the ranking, each candidate will be awarded a score based on the following criteria:

- up to a maximum of 30 points on the basis of candidates' economic situation (ISEE means test value);
- for students who have graduated on track or are enrolled in a bachelor's degree program with direct admission to the master's degree program: up to a maximum of 70 points on the basis of the score determined by the following formula:

$$(C/CM) \times M$$

Where:

M = the weighted average grade of the examinations passed by 28 February 2023 by the candidate for the purposes of obtaining their degree, excluding excess examinations.

C = the number of credits earned by the candidate for the purposes of obtaining their degree and officially recorded by 28 February 2023, excluding excess examinations.

CM = the total number of credits that can be earned by the candidate by 28 February 2023 for the purposes of obtaining their degree, as defined in the Annex to this Call for Applications, of which it is an integral part;

- for students enrolled in a first-level master with direct admission to the master's degree program: up to a maximum of 70 points based on the weighted average grade (up to the second decimal place without rounding off) achieved at the end of their bachelor's degree program;
- for non-Luiss bachelor's degree students or Luiss bachelor's degree students admitted following a selection process: up to a maximum of 70 points based on the admission score.

In the event of a tie, preference will be accorded to the student with the lowest ISEE means test value calculated for the purposes of obtaining aid for university studies.

The outcome of the application will be published in each candidate's own private area by 9 June 2023.

5. Renewal

The scholarship, granted for the standard duration of the degree program, will be renewed for the subsequent academic year on condition that the grantee, by the end of the summer exam session of the first year, has earned at least 70% of the education credits required under their study plan for graduation purposes and has a weighted grade average of not less than 27/30.

6. Submission of Applications

Applications to participate in this competition can be submitted, using the online form available at the Financial Aid web pages, **from 5 April 2023 to noon on 12 May 2023**. Students may apply even before the publication of the results of the admission test, regardless of the outcome. The University itself will proceed to exclude non-admitted students from the competition.

The application form must be accompanied by the following documentation:

- current ISEE means test certificate (***Indicatore della Situazione Economica Equivalente***), valid for the purposes of obtaining aid for university studies; **applications that attach a DSU declaration (*dichiarazione sostitutiva unica*) instead of an ISEE certificate will not be accepted.**
- for international students or students with foreign income, the application form must be accompanied by self-certification regarding the income and assets owned by the family unit in the year 2020, using the form that is Annex 2 to this Call for Applications. The self-certification must be written in Italian or English.
- for non-Luiss students enrolled in a first-level master who meet the requirements for direct admission: a certificate of the exams taken during their bachelor's degree program. Applicants are also required to self-certify on the application form the exams taken during their bachelor's degree program with an indication of the grade and credits obtained for each subject in order to be able to display the weighted average that will be taken into consideration for the purposes of the ranking. Credits obtained in exams with a mere pass-fail grade do not count towards calculating the average.

Only complete applications received by the deadline will be considered.

LUISS Guido Carli disclaims any liability in relation to applications that are not received due to technical issues or reasons attributable to third parties.

7. Revocation

The aid envisaged by this competition will be revoked upon the occurrence of any one of the following:

- a. the student fails to enroll at Luiss Guido Carli for a master's degree program for the 2023/2024 academic year, in which case the scholarship will be allocated to the next highest ranked student;
- b. the student is eligible for the Disco Lazio regional competition for the awarding of scholarships;



- c. the student no longer fulfills the merit requirements specified in article 5 above;
- d. the student discontinues their studies;
- e. the student transfers to another university.
