

Call for applications for the awarding of a scholarship reserved for students who, in the 2023/2024 academic year, will be enrolled in the first year of the master's degree program in Amministrazione, Finanza e Controllo at Luiss University.

1. Subject Matter of the Competition

Luiss University, in conjunction with Fondazione Mario Gasbarri - Alleanza Assicurazioni, announces a competition for the awarding of a scholarship, consisting of a **full waiver** of the University's annual tuition fee, earmarked for students who will enroll, in the 2023/2024 academic year, in the first year of the master's degree program in **Amministrazione, Finanza e Controllo**.

The scholarship is intended to honor the memory of Mario Gasbarri who led Alleanza Assicurazioni for forty years, first as general manager and then as president. Gasbarri went through both world wars and during the reconstruction years he personally dedicated himself to helping young and old cope in those hard times. An optimistic and pragmatic man, he put concrete solutions into practice, believing in the importance of investing in training and in valuing talent. His principles in Alliance still keep his memory alive today.

2. Eligibility

This competition is open to students who:

- are enrolled in the 2022/2023 academic year in a bachelor's degree program at Luiss University or another Italian university;
- have completed **on track (in corso)** all the examinations provided for in their study plan by the deadline for submission of applications for this competition, with the exception of the final examination for graduating students.

This competition is not open to students who will be attending a master's degree program abroad in the 2023/2024 because admitted to the following international mobility programs:

- BI-Luiss Joint MSc in Marketing;
- Double Master in Policies and Governance in Europe with King's College;
- Double Master in International Management with King's College.

3. Incompatibility

The aid envisaged by this competition is incompatible with other tuition fee waivers or scholarships held for any reason whatsoever, except for those awarded by Italian or foreign institutions designed to

support, through periods abroad, a student's education for the academic years covered by this competition.

4. Awarding of the Aid

For the purposes of compiling the ranking, each candidate will be awarded a score based on the following criteria:

- up to a maximum of 15 points on the basis of candidates' economic situation (ISEE means test value);
- up to a maximum of 85 points on the basis of the weighted average grade achieved during the bachelor's degree program.

In the event of a tie, preference will be accorded to the student with the lowest ISEE means test value calculated for the purposes of obtaining aid for university studies.

The ranking will be published in each candidate's own private area by 31 July 2023.

5. Renewal of the Scholarship

The scholarship, awarded for the standard duration of the degree program, will be renewed in the following academic year on condition that the recipient, by the end of the summer exam session of the first year, has earned at least 70% of the education credits required under their study plan for graduation purposes and also has a weighted average grade of not less than 27/30.

6. Submission of Applications

Applications must be submitted through the online application form available on the Financial Aid Office webpages, **between 1 June and noon on 4 July 2023**.

The application form must be accompanied by the following documentation uploaded as attachments:

- Current ISEE means test certificate (***indicatore della situazione economica equivalente***), valid for the purposes of obtaining aid for university studies. **Applications that attach a DSU declaration (*Dichiarazione Sostitutiva Unica*) instead of an ISEE certificate will not be accepted.** If the student is not an Italian citizen or a foreign citizen residing in Italy with Italian income, the ISEE value will be calculated by the University on the basis of the self-certification issued by the person concerned regarding the composition of their family unit and income and assets held abroad in 2021. The self-certification must be made using the form annexed to this call for applications (Annex) in Italian or English, under penalty of exclusion from the competition.
- For students coming from a university other than Luiss University: a certificate of the exams taken during their bachelor's degree program. Applicants are also required to self-certify on the application form the exams taken during their bachelor's degree program with an indication of

the grade and credits obtained for each subject in order to be able to display the weighted average that will be taken into consideration for the purposes of compiling the ranking. Credits obtained in exams with a mere pass-fail grade (*idoneità*) do not count towards calculating the average.

Only complete applications actually received by the deadline will be considered. Luiss University disclaims any liability in relation to applications that are not received due to technical issues or reasons attributable to third parties.

7. Revocation

The aid envisaged by this competition will be revoked upon the occurrence of any one of the following:

- a. the student fails to enroll in the master's degree program at Luiss University for the 2023/2024 academic year, in which case the scholarship will be allocated to the next highest ranked student;
- b. the student is eligible for the Disco Lazio regional competition for the awarding of scholarships;
- c. the student no longer fulfills the requirements necessary for renewal, as specified in Article 5 above;
- d. the student discontinues their studies;
- e. the student transfers to another university.
