Important Rules

- This study plan is designed for students taking part in the mentioned Double Degree Program and spending the academic year 2025-26 at Gothenburg.
- The list of courses to be taken abroad may be subject to changes should the academic offer at Gothenburg be amended.
- Interested students are required to read and understand the study plan and its rules. These are to be considered binding to the successful completion of the double degree program. Changes to the study plan are usually not possible. Any request in this sense must be conveyed to the International Development Office and the Academic Coordinator, that will evaluate the request.
- The listed exams must be taken and passed in the academic year indicated in the scheme (not after). Any possible change must be formally authorized by the Academic Commission.
- During the mobility, students will be subject to the rules of the University of Gothenburg.
- At the end of the program, if compliant with both Luiss and Gothenburg academic requirements, students will obtain both the MSc in Innovation and Industrial Management (issued by Gothenburg) and the Laurea Magistrale in Management (issued by Luiss).
- Please consider that attendance is mandatory during the 1st and 2nd semester of the 2nd year
 at Gothenburg. Special requests from students who would like to have an internship experience
 will be evaluated by the master program coordinator of Innovation and Industrial Management
 at the University of Gothenburg who reserves the right to accept the student request analyzing
 candidates' dossier, the timeline of the proposed internship and the possibility to match the
 internship experience with the thesis research work.

Thesis

- Students will complete their theses during their mobility period with two supervisors, and this is an individual work.
- Both supervisors have to approve the proposal, which must meet the standards of both institutions.
- Students must respect the thesis procedures and deadlines from both institutions.
- Students are reminded that they are required to comply with the Luiss regular procedure
 regarding the thesis assignment, registration for the degree exam and upload of the thesis. For

- Each institution will grade the final thesis according to its own standards.

Note on the thesis process at the University of Gothenburg

Students are required to attend a thesis course in the second semester of their mobility year at the University of Gothenburg. The course is designed to be offered in Gothenburg, therefore Luiss students are expected to be in Gothenburg to work on the thesis, attend group workshops and present their theses in the group. Presenting the thesis, opposing another thesis, and handing in the final thesis are mandatory activities to graduate from the University of Gothenburg. The presentation takes place in May; the thesis handover takes place in June.



Note on the thesis process at Luiss

The final examination of Master's Degree Programs at Luiss consists of a discussion and evaluation of a written dissertation (thesis). The thesis project must be developed by the student under the guidance of both the Supervisor (chosen by the student based on the dissertation topic) and Co-Supervisor (allocated by default). To take the final examination, it is mandatory to register to the Degree Session.

An academic year includes three degree sessions: Summer (normally June/July), Autumn (normally October/November) and Extraordinary (normally March/April).

DD students can graduate in any of these sessions, however it is important to note that there are internal Luiss deadlines that both students (from Luiss and Gothenburg) need to respect. These deadlines are published on the following web page:
