- This study plan is designed for students taking part in the mentioned Structured Partnership Program and spending the academic year 2025/2026 at Paris Dauphine.
- Interested students are required to read and understand the study plan and its rules. These are to be considered binding to the successful completion of the program.
- During the mobility, students will be subject to the rules of Paris Dauphine.
- The list of courses to be taken abroad may be subject to changes should the academic offer at Paris Dauphine be amended.

¹ Students who have successfully passed the second language course during the 2nd year at Luiss can take the French language course at Dauphine on a voluntary basis.

² In case of lesson overlap between Comparative Business Law and both The Art of Negotiation, and Organizational Behavior, it will be possible to substitute Comparative Business Law with one of the other two courses.

- In addition to the courses listed above, students will be required to complete the Final Work (4 ECTS), according to Luiss' rules and with a Luiss supervisor.
- Students participating in this program may not be able to graduate at Luiss in July 2026 but will be able to do so in October/November 2026, provided they pass all exams.
- Exams passed at the partner university during the mobility period will be transferred to the Luiss career according to the Structured Exchange study plan. It is not possible to request an official renounce of the grades registration.
